BEFORE THE TRIAL:

Riders and minders to not walk the sections until after 17:00 on Friday 27th, doing so could result in disqualification.

INFORMATION

- No practising before of after the event is allowed for reasons of insurance.
- No riding through the car park and campsite outside of permitted trial times.
- There is a designated no-activity period before your assigned start time (i.e. no starting or warming up of bikes).

THE TRIAL:

- Trial consists of 3 laps of 12 sections.
- Sections must be ridden in ascending numerical order.
- Riders will start in groups at 1 minute intervals but at different sections this will be displayed at the signing on desk and Parc Ferme.
- Riders will be given a start time all times will also be displayed at the signing on desk and Parc Ferme.
- Time penalties will be incurred if the rider is late starting/finishing from their designated time.
- Riders must not delay the publication of the results.
- The underpass beneath the motorway will be zoned to keep pedestrians & riders apart. Do not ride on the side of the underpass marked for pedestrians. Keep to the left in your direction of travel when using the 'riders only' zone through the underpass, ride no faster than walking pace.
- Riders must ride at a safe and sensible speed between sections and use the
 designated route (do not ride in the reverse direction of the route). Travelling
 Marshals will ensure that riders are not presenting any danger to other riders,
 spectators and officials. If a rider is found to be riding dangerously, they will
 receive a Yellow Card and this will be reported to the Clerk of the Course.
- Riders/Minders/Parents who are abusive to any official or any other person will be given a yellow card and reported to the clerk of the course/ACU.
- All minders to be on foot (i.e. no ebikes etc.)
- Minders to only go in sections with permission from the observer, and only then when it is their riders turn to ride.
- All machines must stand on an environmental mat whilst being refuelled.
- If any of the above is contravened by the rider, it could result in disqualification.

NEAREST PETROL STATIONS:


Coventry Road - LE9 6QD (approx. 1 mile) Hinckley (approx. 4 miles)


JOIN US NEXT YEAR AND PRACTICE ALL YEAR ROUND!
